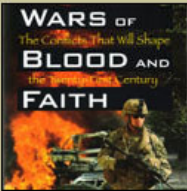
**Summer Campaign 2007 Military History Tournament**

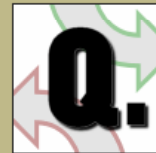
