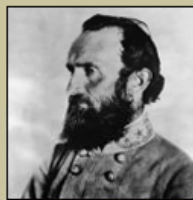
January 2008 Issue Approaches

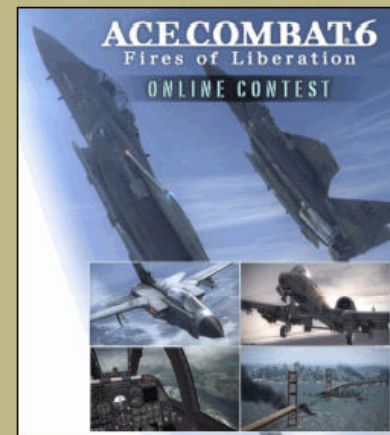
